



LEED VERIFICATION DOCUMENT

This document verifies that sod and plug grasses from Todd Valley Farms can enable project teams to earn credits for the LEED® Certification of New Construction, Major Renovations, or Existing Buildings. The products below qualify under the Water Efficient Landscaping Credit – WE 1.

These grasses are water efficient. Each variety will survive with little irrigation or no irrigation system. They place significantly less demand on potable and non potable water use or an alternative water source such as cistern, graywater recycling, or other raincatchment system.

By virtue of their low-water requirements these products enable projects to earn up to 4 LEED points. There are three approaches to earn points for the Water Efficient Landscaping LEED Credit:

- 1. Reduce potable water usage by 50% (2 points)
2. Use no potable water for irrigation (4 points)
3. Use no irrigation system after one year of installation (4 points)

The number of points earned will depend on water efficiency of the rest of your landscaping plan.
